Sunday Dec 11th

First part Strong winds from S.W. with cloudy weather ship by the wind heading to the Southward at sundown took in sail Middle and latter part the same
Lat 44° 33' S.
Long 164° 29' E.

Monday Dec 12th

First part light gale from South with squally weather ship by the wind heading to the S.E. under storm sails middle part strong breeze latter part moderate breeze with fine weather ship by the wind heading to the S.E.
Lat 44° 14' S.
Long 165° 26' E.

Tuesday Dec 13th

First part moderate breeze from S.W. with cloudy weather ship by the wind heading to the S.E. at sundown took in sail latter part wind from South ship heading to the weather
Lat 45° 15' S.
Long 164° 34' E.

Wednesday Dec 14th

First part Moderate breeze from South with pleasant weather ship by the wind heading to the Westward at sundown took in sail Middle and latter part calm crew employed in different jobs about the ship
Lat 45° 09' S.
Long 164° 09' E.

Thursday Dec 15th

First part Moderate breeze from north with pleasant weather ship steering S.W. at 6 P.M. spoke the Bark Union of Sydney Middle and latter part Moderate gale from north with such weather ship bore to heading to the west at midnight the wind hauled to the west ship steering S.E.
Lat 45° 30' S.
Long 163° 59' E.

Friday Dec 16th

First part fresh breeze from west with cloudy weather ship steering off course S.E. at 6 P.M. took in sail luffed to heading to the South Middle and latter part Moderate gale from S.W. with clear weather ship bore to heading to the South
Lat 46° 01' S.
Long 164° 38' E.

Saturday Dec 17th

First part Moderate gale from S.W. with clear weather ship bore to heading to the South Middle and latter part Moderate breeze from west with heavy weather ship steering to the Eastward
Lat 46° 03' S.
Long 165° 20' E.

Sunday Dec 18th

First part Moderate breeze from N.W. with heavy weather ship steering E. by N. at sundown took in sail Middle and latter part Moderate gale from north with squalling weather ship bore to heading to the West at midnight the wind hauled to the S.W.
No Ob.

Monday Dec 19th

Commenced with fresh breeze from S.W. with foggy weather ship heading to the Southward Middle and latter part light breeze at daylight stood off N.E. at 10 A.M. sighted Sander Island bearing N.E.
Lat 46° 58' S.

Tuesday Dec 20th

Commenced with moderate breeze from East with cloudy weather at noon raised spinn whaler going East observed and got one to the water took the fish boiled and stuck on and laid him down Mark bearing N.E. 25 miles distant at dark commenced cutting at 10 P.M. Moderate gale at midnight worked off cutting weather being too rough to cut latter part fresh gale from west ship bore to heading to the S.W. with the whale along side
Lat 47° 12' S.
Long 166° 34' E.
