Monday April 3rd First and latter part of the day fresh breeze from S.E. with heavy rain. At 4 P.M. the second anchor

Tuesday April 4th First part of the day fresh gale from N.E. with rainy weather. Latter part calm and hauled to the N.W. and cleared way got off on Boxer one lot of shooks and commenced to set him up

Wednesday April 5th Fine weather employed in setting up shooks for water took the mud sail out of the sail room and moved them in cabin

Thursday April 6th Fine weather employed in setting up cask for water took one of the box ways took off one box plank and put on a shackle

Friday April 7th Fine weather employed in setting up cask for water sent a raft ashore and filled it

Saturday April 8th Fine weather employed in setting up cask and got off raft of water stored part of it below decks

Sunday April 9th Fine weather nothing doing

Monday April 10th Fine weather employed in setting up cask for water got off small raft of water and stored it in the after hold

Tuesday April 11th Good weather employed in setting up cask for water took on board a launch load of wood and a small raft of water

Wednesday April 12th Fine weather employed in setting up cask and got off raft of water and ran it in the tank

Thursday April 13th Fine weather employed in setting up cask got off raft of water launch load of wood and two boxes of potatoes and stored off part of the for hold and sent a raft for timber

Friday April 14th Fine weather employed in cooping cask for the ground tier and storing the ground tier in the fore hold got a launch load of shooks and took home the and getting the water tank took off a launch load of wood

Saturday April 15th Fine weather employed in storing off the fore hold and stored it

Sunday April 16th Squally weather under from west

Monday April 17th Squally weather employed in getting off provisions and storing them in the fore hold and took off a small quantity of wood
