

Barb. Matelosa Sears

Friday April 28th

First part light air from N.W. with foggy weather ship steering to the south under easy sail at sundown luffed to the wind heading to the westward Middle and latter part calm with clear weather at Meridian Milford Haven bore S. by E. 20 miles dist

Saturday April 29th

First part calm with pleasant weather Middle and latter part light breeze from north with fine weather ship steering different course at Meridian Milford Haven bore East 25 miles dist

Sunday April 30th

First part moderate breeze from north with pleasant weather ship steering various courses at sundown took in sail latter part fresh breeze from south with clear weather ship steering different course at Meridian Milford Haven bore S. by E. 25 miles dist

Monday May 1st

First part fresh breeze from south with pleasant weather at sundown took in sail Middle part calm latter part fresh breeze from north with pleasant weather ship heading to the westward at Meridian Milford Haven bore S. by E. 60 miles dist

Tuesday May 2nd

First part fresh breeze from north with pleasant weather ship steering various courses under double reef topsails Middle and latter part wind the same ship by the wind heading to the eastward at Meridian Milford Haven bore S. by E. 20 miles dist

Wednesday May 3rd

First part Moderate gale from north with cloudy weather ship bore to the westward Middle and latter part wind the same with rainy weather No. 10

Thursday May 4th

First part Moderate gale from north with rainy weather ship bore to the westward at sundown the wind hauled to the S.W. ship heading to the S. at Meridian land in sight bearing S. by E. 10 miles dist

Friday May 5th

First part Moderate gale from S.W. with squally weather ship bore to the S. by E. in the forenoon to the westward Middle part the same latter part more moderate ship steering various courses under short sail at Meridian Milford Haven bore East E. 25 miles dist

Saturday May 6th

First part fresh breeze from S.W. with squally weather ship steering to the northward at sundown luffed to the wind heading to the westward latter part light breeze from west with cloudy weather ship by the wind heading to the north and the land bore out latter and coffee

Sunday May 7th

First part light breeze from west with cloudy weather at sundown luffed to the southward and took in sail Middle and latter part fresh breeze from the west with squally weather sail asail and the land
