Tuesday June 6th First part Strong
winds from S.W. with squally weather
at 1 P.M. more ship to the westward
Middle part wind from S.E. ship steering course
W.N.W. latter part wind from East ship steering
W.N.W. Lat. 14° 21' N. Long 154° 55' W.

Wednesday June 7th First part fresh breeze
from the Eastward with squally weather ship
steering N.W. at 1 P.M. sighted the land
at Sumner's station sail latter part moderate
breeze with clear weather ship steering to the N.W. until
the land at Breiden's Southwest Cape was
N.W. 20 miles distant

Thursday June 8th First part moderate breeze
from East with pleasant weather ship steering
to the N.W. at Sumner's took in sail spoke
the prize Kotacefi Middle and latter part
light breeze from S.W. ship steering to the N.W.
the Breiden's Port Darcy was East 25 miles distant

Friday June 9th First part light breeze
from S.W. with cloudy weather ship steering to the
N.W. at Sumner's took in sail and were ship
to the S.E. Middle and latter part the same
at Breiden's Southwest Cape was East 15
miles distant William Butcher went on duty

Saturday June 10th First part moderate
breeze from S.W. with cloudy weather ship to the
westward heading to the Southward at 1 P.M. were
ship to the west Middle part fresh breeze
from North latter part the wind hauled on
to the S.W. with rain ship heading to the
N.W. under short sail. Saw the land
on 11

Sunday June 11th First part light gale
from S.W. with cloudy weather ship have to
heading to the N.W. Middle part the same
latter part wind from west with squally weather
ship to the west heading to the northward
at Breiden's Port Darcy was East 11 miles distant

Monday June 12th First part squally
weather wind from north to S.W. at 1 P.M. were
ship to the Southward Middle and latter
part wind from West at 2 P.M. were ship to the
N.W. at Breiden's Southwest Cape was north 8
miles distant

Tuesday June 13th First part Strong
winds from westward with clear weather
ship to the west heading to the S.W.
saw Pasail Middle and latter part moderate
gale from north with cloudy weather ship have to heading
to the westward

Wednesday June 14th First part fresh gale
from north with thick weather ship have to heading
to the westward Middle part the same latter
part wind from S.W. at day high were ship to the
N.W. Lat. 14° 21' N. Long 154° 28' W.

Thursday June 15th First part moderate
gale from S.W. with squally weather ship have
to heading to the N.W. latter part Strong
winds from West ship heading to the north
Lat. 13° 58' N. Long 155° 05' W.
