Moderate breeze from westward with fair and weather at 3 P.M. sea account got underway and started out of the river & Smeaton's Store the anchor and crossed the water at 10 then at 11 P.M. the wind off duty and

Tuesday Nov 28th

Commenced with fresh breeze from westward with heavy weather ship steering S. by E. Middle road on some late and wind from "V. W." at 3 P.M. then at 11.00 the wind hauled to the west and employed in different jobs about the ship at 1.00 P.M. went off duty with the
