Commence with fresh breeze from west with hazy weather ship steering East under all bearing sail Middle and latter part fresh gale with changeable weather No Ob.

Thursday Dec 30th

Commence with fresh gale from west with squally weather ship steering course East under all bearing sail Middle and latter part same No Ob.

Friday Dec 31st

Commence with fresh gale from west with squally weather at 4 P. M. the wind hauled to the S. W. at 6 we took all sail but close reef main topsail and hove to heading to the S. E. latter part more moderate at 3 P. M. steered East and set the topsails double reefed

Saturday Dec 1st

Commence with light gale from S. W. with fair weather ship steering to N. E. Middle and latter part fresh breeze from west and rugged S. Main well off

Sunday Dec 2nd

Commence with fresh breeze from west with cloudy weather ship steering to S. E. at 3 P. M. huffed to and took in sail having a gale Middle part wind from N. W. latter part wind from S. W. with cloudy weather ship to the wind heading to the Southward at day light Soloron Island bore East 15 miles distant
Lat 16° 41' S
Long 166° 37' E

Monday Dec 3rd

Commence with strong breeze from S. W. with cloudy weather in the morning Middle and latter part moderate breeze ship to the wind on opposite tack at midday Soloron bore N. E. 20 miles distant

Tuesday Dec 4th

Ship part fresh breeze from N. W. with cloudy weather Middle part heavy gale from N. W. ship hove to heading to the Southward Middle part the wind hauled to the west steered the wind hauled on the trines & turned up
Lat 17° 18' S

Wednesday Dec 5th

Commence with light gale from west with changeable weather hove to heading to the Southward Middle part the same latter part fresh gale with squally weather ship hove to heading to the South
