Commenced with moderate breeze from S.E. with pleasant weather ship on opposite tack. Middle and latter part wind and weather the same ship by the wind heading to the south crew employed in different jobs about the ship.

Commenced with moderate breeze from East with pleasant weather ship by the wind heading to the south. Middle and latter part weather the same crew employed in different jobs about the ship.

Wednesday Jan 17th

Commenced with light breeze from East with pleasant weather ship by the wind heading to the south. Middle part wind from N.E. latter part calm crew employed in ship duty.

Commenced with light air and calm with pleasant weather ship steering to the northward. Middle and latter part light air from west with fine weather crew employed in getting out provisions and molasses and doing other jobs about the ship.

Commenced with light breeze from west with pleasant weather ship steering to the N.W. Middle and latter part light air and calm crew employed in making gunnery.

Commenced with light air and calm with pleasant weather. Middle and latter part the same at 9 A.M. raised sperm whale found the boats in chase the whale.
