Commenced with light breeze from East with pleasant weather ship steering various courses at sundown took in sail Middle and latter part fresh breeze from N.E. saw a sail and one of the crew employed in different jobs about the ship
Lat. 31° 19' S.

Sunday Oct 4th

Commenced with fresh breeze from N.E. with pleasant weather ship on opposite tack saw a ship whaling at sundown took in sail Middle and latter part same at 10 P.M. the black sea
Lat. 31° 12' S.
East 20 miles out

Monday Oct 5th

Commenced with moderate breeze from N.E. with pleasant weather ship on opposite tack spoke the ship Tiger and got a boat from her latter part the same
Lat. 32° 21' S.
Long 178° 14' E.

Tuesday Oct 6th

Commenced with light breeze from N.E. with pleasant weather ship on opposite tack at sundown took in sail Middle and latter part calm crew employed in making spungyarn
Lat. 32° 12' S.
Long 178° 05' E.

Wednesday Oct 7th

Commenced with calm with pleasant weather Middle and latter part moderate breeze from N.E. with heavy weather ship heading to the N.W. crew employed in different jobs about the ship
Lat. 31° 15' S.
Long 178° 30' E.

Thursday Oct 8th

Commenced with fresh breeze from N.E. with heavy weather ship heading to the N.W. at sundown took in sail Middle and latter part the same crew employed in different jobs about the ship saw the black
Lat. 31° 08' S.
Long 179° 19' E.

Friday Oct 9th

Commenced with fresh breeze from N.E. with pleasant weather at 1 P.M. saw ship to the S.E. at sundown took in sail Middle and latter part moderate breeze ship on opposite tack crew employed in getting meat and water
Lat. 31° 08' S.
Long 179° 21' E.

Saturday Oct 10th

Commenced with light breeze from Eastward with pleasant weather ship heading to the north at sundown took in sail Middle and latter part fresh breeze from S.E. crew employed in different jobs about the ship
Lat. 31° 29' S.
Long 178° 05' E.
