Monday Oct 19th

Commence with strong breeze from N.E. with dark hazy weather. Middle and latter part of the gale from N.E. with rain. Squalls ship bore to on opposite tack to the

Tuesday Oct 20th

Commence with light gale from N.E. with rain. Squalls ship bore to heading to the N.W. Middle and latter part wind of the same with hazy weather Lat. 32° 52' S Long 139° 08' W

Wednesday Oct 21st

Commence with strong breeze from the north with hazy weather and fogged at 1 P.M. were ship to the West Middle and latter part more moderate with fog. Squalls ship on opposite tack to the

Thursday Oct 22nd

Commence with fresh breeze from north with squally weather. Ship to the wind heading to the west Middle and latter part wind more moderate with hazy weather at 1 P.M. were ship to the East crew employed in different jobs about the ship Lat. 32° 19' S Long 139° 30' W

Cruising off the French Rock 1872

Friday Oct 23rd

Commence with moderate breeze from north with hazy weather. Ship to the wind heading to the East Middle and latter part the same crew employed in odd jobs about the ship Lat. 32° 20' S Long 138° 11' W

Saturday Oct 24th

Commence with a calm latter part light air from S.E. ship steering N.W. by W. crew employed in putting up the fore rigging Lat. 32° 10' S Long 138° 18' W

Sunday Oct 25th

Commence with light breeze from S.E. with pleasant weather latter part the same ship steering various courses saw the Rock bearing to the westward Lat. 31° 38' S

Monday Oct 26th

Commence with fresh breeze from S.E. with pleasant weather Middle and latter the same ship steering various courses & making the Rock bore N. 10 miles distant crew employed in get out water out of the fore hold and put it in the tank and got out provisions
