jobs about the ship Lat. 32° 45' S.
Long 138° 35' W

Sunday May 5th Commence with
moderate breeze from North with cloudy weather
ship by the wind heading to the West
mistake and latter part light gale from
North ship heading to the West
no Ob

Monday May 6th Commence with fresh
gale from North with rainy weather ship heading
to the West latter part wind from West
ship heading to the North Lat. 32° 02' S.
Long 139° 30' W

Tuesday May 7th Commence with fresh
breeze from S.W. with squally weather ship steering
to the North at sunset took in sail and lapped
to the Eastward Oniscle and latter part light
breeze from S.E. with pleasant weather & daylight
steered off to the Northwest said the French Rock
bearing to the East and astail Lat. 31° 21' S.

Wednesday May 8th Commence with
moderate breeze from S.E. with pleasant weather
latter part strong wind from East with
cloudy weather ship steering various course
Lat. 31° 21' S.

Thursday May 9th Commence with
strong wind from East with rainy weather
ship heading to the South latter part
fresh gale with heavy rain ship heading
to the South turned up the Starboard boat
at Meridian the wind hauled to the West sudden
flouring fresh Lat. 30° 51' S.
got no clothes for the men Long 139° 15' W
