

# Bark. Matilda Sears

Monday July 29<sup>th</sup>

Commence with strong breeze from S.W. with clear weather ship by the river heading to the S.E. Moderate and latter part wind and weather the same ship on opposite tack took the ceiling out of the starboard head and washed her out A point at meridian Javari Bay bore west 15 miles dist

Tuesday July 30<sup>th</sup>

Commence with moderate breeze from west with clear weather ship heading to the Northward Moderate and latter part wind from S.W. ship on opposite tack at meridian Javari Bay bore S.W. 20 miles dist

Wednesday July 31<sup>st</sup>

Commence with fresh breeze from S.W. with pleasant weather Moderate and latter part wind the same ship by the river on opposite tack repaired the fore stay sail and head it at meridian Javari Bay bore S.W. 25 miles dist

Thursday August 1<sup>st</sup>

Commence with fresh breeze from S.W. with cloudy weather Moderate and latter part light variable winds with pleasant weather ship on opposite tack crew employed on staggard tack in repairing the fore gallant sail at meridian Javari Bay bore west 25 miles dist Sailed two sails

# Cruising off Javari Bay 1872

Friday Aug 2<sup>nd</sup>

Commence with moderate breeze from S.W. with pleasant weather latter part strong winds from S.W. ship by the river on opposite tack Sailed three sails at meridian Pigeon House bore west 25 miles dist

Saturday Aug 3<sup>rd</sup>

Commence with fresh breeze from S.W. with clear weather latter part wind from north with hazy weather ship steering to the south at meridian Tromasary Mountain bore west 20 miles dist took out water out of the fore hold and filled the tank

Sunday Aug 4<sup>th</sup>

Commence with fresh breeze from North with hazy weather at 4 P.M. luffed to the wind heading off shore latter part moderate breeze from N.W. with pleasant weather ship heading to the N.E. Sailed the land

Monday Aug 5<sup>th</sup>

Commence with light breeze from N.W. with pleasant weather at 10 o'clock went ship to the westward latter wind from South with rain squalls ship heading to the westward at meridian Tromasary Mountain bore N.W. 25 miles dist
