

Bark. Matilda Seas

Thursday Aug 15th

Commence with moderate breeze from north with heavy weather ship steering various courses at 11 o'clock took in 12 sail latter part wind the same ship steering to the southward said number of vessels was meridian Cajon house bore N. N. W. 25 miles out

Friday Aug 16th

Commence with moderate breeze from north with heavy weather at 11 o'clock took in 12 sail and latter the wind latter part light tapping air said three vessels at meridian Cape Hornedary bore west 2 miles out

Saturday Aug 17th

Commence with moderate breeze from N. E. with heavy weather ship by the wind heading to Cape S. E. Pringle and latter part light variable breeze ship by the wind on opposite tack said three vessels about and heard astoop from Malbourn sound to Sydney at meridian Cape Hornedary bore N. N. W. 30 miles out

Sunday Aug 18th

Commence with moderate breeze from N. E. with pleasant weather Pringle and latter part light air from N. E. ship on opposite tack said land and two sails in sight spoke the Bark Minerva

Cruising off Jarvis Bay 1872

Monday Aug 19th

Commence with light air from N. E. with pleasant weather latter part strong wind from South with rainy weather at 11 o'clock ship steered off to the north with the land in sight said number of vessels

Tuesday Aug 20th

Commence with strong breeze from South with cloudy weather at 11 o'clock shifted to the wind heading to the East Pringle and latter part light gale with clear weather at 10 o'clock ship steered off to the north at meridian Cape Hornedary bore west 15 miles out said vessel

Wednesday Aug 21st

Commence with light gale from South with clear weather at 2 o'clock ship shifted to heading to the west Pringle and latter part wind and weather the same ship on opposite tack said one sail at meridian Cajon house bore west 15 miles out

Thursday Aug 22nd

Commence with fresh gale from South with squally weather ship shifted to the eastward thickened up the boats Pringle and latter part the same No Obs.
