Commenced with a fresh gale from South with squally weather ship here to heading to the Eastward. Moderate part the same latter part more moderate. No Ob.

Friday Aug 24th

Commenced with moderate gale from S.W. with cloudy weather at 1 P.M. were ship to the westward. Moderate and latter part fresh gale with squally weather at 2 P.M. were ship to the S.E. at 3 P.M. were back to the westward.

Saturday Aug 25th

Commenced with moderate gale from S.E. with clear weather ship heading to the westward. Latter part calm.

Commenced with moderate breeze from north with pleasant weather ship steering to the westward at sundown took in sail blowing a gale from north. Moderate and latter part a gale from north with heavy weather at 10 P.M. made the land at Meridian. Jarvis Bay 10 miles east and at

Thursday Aug 27th

Commenced with fresh gale from S.W. with heavy weather ship here to heading to the S.W. Latter part wind hauler to the South. Moderate ship heading to the west at Meridian. Pigeon house 15 miles east got into land at 11.

Friday Aug 28th

Commenced with strong breeze from South with cloudy weather at sundown were ship to the Eastward. Moderate and latter part strong breeze and squally ship on different tack and four sails at Meridian. Pigeon house 10 miles east.

Saturday Aug 29th

Commenced with strong breeze with cloudy weather ship steering to the north at sundown shifted to the wind. Moderate and latter part light breeze from South ship on opposite tack and number of vessels spoke the Bark Muramatsu at Meridian. Jarvis Bay 10 miles east.

Sunday Aug 30th

Commenced with light breeze from S.E. with pleasant weather. Moderate and latter part wind from North with squally weather ship steering to the South and three sails. Spoke the Bark Aladdin at Meridian. Hornadary Mountain 20 miles east.
