Fine weather at 6 A.M. got underway from the wharf and made sail for the ship. At 10 A.M. got on the ship and the carpenters went to work on the sheathing where it was worn eating. Held a survey on the ship.

Saturday Sept 19th

Fine weather, carpenters employed in repairing the sheathing on the starboard side of the ship. Side.

Sunday Sept 20th

Fine weather at 10 A.M. landed on the ship off the ship and worked at the wharf until 11 A.M. came to the wharf and worked at the wharf. Latter part of the day employed in painting iron work and the sheathing and setting up cask for water.

Fine weather and employed in painting the iron work on the side and setting up cask for water received on board 10 tuns of beef and some other small job about the ship.

Tuesday Sept 22nd

Showery weather

Thursday Sept 24th

Fine weather and employed in storing off the fore hold and running water into the cask received on board and topsail.

Friday Sept 25th

Fine weather and employed in painting outside and the cooper setting up cask for water.
