

Bark. Antelope Star

Wednesday Nov 27th

In moderate weather commenced with latter part of same crew employed in building

Thursday Nov 28th

Fine weather at 4 P.M. finished building latter part weather the same employed in stowing oil in the fore hold

Friday Nov 29th

Fine weather finished stowing off the hold

Saturday Nov 30th

Commenced with fresh gale from N.W. with over cast weather. Middle and latter part heavy rain at 10 A.M. got underway with squally winds from South-west. Sailed at 10 A.M. for the westward through the straits

Sunday 1st Dec 1st

Raffling breeze with cloudy weather this morning to the westward in the straits. Middle and latter part strong winds from west with heavy weather ship beating to the west under all bearing sail at meridian rugged Point Barrow N. 10 miles distant

Cruising off Staranor 1878

Monday Dec 2nd

Commenced with strong current from west with heavy weather and rugged ship beating to the west. Middle and latter part blowing fresh with rain and squalls ship on opposite tack under all bearing sail land on both sides of the meridian was this of the south side of the middle island land 2 miles distant

Tuesday Dec 3rd

Commenced with a gale from west with squally rainy weather ship on opposite tack under all bearing sail very heavy rugged sea rolling from the west at Staranor. Sailed at 12 miles distant. Middle and latter part blowing again from west with heavy squalls ship on opposite tack under all bearing sail laboring hard in the sea way land astern steering to the east

Wednesday Dec 4th

Commenced with gale from west with heavy squalls and a large sea running ship on opposite tack under all bearing sail at 4 P.M. Sailed at 10 miles distant at 10 P.M. for Point Barrow and the weather looking threatening. Middle and latter part strong winds with squalls ship working to the westward at meridian. Sailed at 10 miles distant
