Wednesday April 2nd

Commenced with light gale from west with hazy weather this morning at 10 P.M. the wind hauled to the eastward the latter part under from N.N.W. ship steering by the wind to the N.E. at daylight made the land Cape Horn 106 N. 25 miles east Lat 55° 51' S Long 65° 30' W

Thursday April 3rd

Commenced with fresh breeze from north with hazy weather this morning the wind heading to the eastward land three vessels going to the westward Middle and latter part wind more moderate than by the wind heading to east No Ob

Friday April 4th

Commenced with light breeze from north with cloudy weather at 10 P.M. the wind hauled to the South steered course N. by E. Middle and latter part moderate breeze from South with pleasant weather this steering N. by E. and sail Lat 53° 54' S Long 60° 21' W

Saturday April 5th

Commenced with light breeze from South with pleasant weather this steering N. by E. under all standing sail Middle and latter part moderate breeze from north ship by the wind heading to the East sail asail to the leeward Lat 52° 59' S Long 56° 53' W

Sunday April 6th

Commenced with fresh breeze from north with pleasant weather this morning the wind heading to the East at sundown latter part wind the same with rainy weather No Ob

Monday April 7th

Commenced with moderate breeze from north with thick weather this morning heading to the East Middle and latter part wind also weather the same at 10 P.M. was ship to the westward No Ob

Tuesday April 8th

Commenced with moderate breeze from North with thick rainy weather this morning the wind heading to the westward at 10 P.M. was ship to the East latter part light gale from N.N.W. with hazy weather this by the wind heading to the N.E. under all standing sail No Ob

Wednesday April 9th

Commenced with light gale from N.N.W. with hazy weather this morning heading to the East at 10 P.M. the wind hauled to the N.N.W. ship heading to the North Middle and latter part moderate gale from N.N.W. ship steering N. by E. at 10 P.M. was took in sail and here the heading to the N.N.W. No Ob
