

Bark Praticola Seas

Thursday June 5th Commenced with light breeze from South with pleasant weather ship steering N. by W. Middle and latter part fresh breeze from S. W. with squally weather Lat 33° 52' N Long 70° 38' W

Friday June 6th Commenced with strong breeze from S. W. with hazy weather ship steering N. by W. under all sail latter part variable wind with squalls commencing and lightening and number of sails Lat 36° 14' N Long 70° 13' W

Saturday June 7th Commenced with light baffling wind with squalls ship working to the north latter part the same Lat 37° 19' N Long 70° 13' W

Sunday June 8th Commenced with fresh breeze from N. W. with cloudy weather ship by 6 AM wind heading to the N. E. at 6 P. M. tacked ship to the west Middle part wind from North ship on opposite tack latter part light gale from north ship under short sail and at number of vessels Lat 38° 18' N

Steering to the North in the R. Atlantic 1878

Monday June 9th Commenced with moderate gale from North with cloudy weather ship have to heading to the west under double reef main top sail and fore sail latter part more moderate wind from the North ship by 6 PM wind on opposite tack Lat 39° 09' N Long 71° 55' W

Tuesday June 10th Commenced with calm with pleasant weather at 10 P. M. got slight breeze from S. W. ship steering N. by W. and at number of sails Lat 40° 42' N Long 71° 35' W

Wednesday June 11th Commenced with light breeze from S. W. with hazy weather ship steering N. N. E. at 1 P. M. made Block Island bearing North 8 miles distant at sundown got the anchor off the bow and took in the light sail
