Sunday March 22 Ship in port Fine weather loosed sails to day the howers of eleven and twelve the men departed

Monday March 23 Fine weather Ship in port Cooper employed setting up Shook Crenshawford getting Water and Wood at four till the men was brought in by the Howies and lodged in the Calibos

Tuesday March 24 Ship in port the Crenshawford Stowing the in the four & main hole the Cooper setting up Shook this day fine weather at ten PM brought five of the Deeters on board Frank Spooner Joseph Hooker Frank Maldon John Diamond Parker and George Clark Boat Steerer

Wednesday ~~Thursday~~ March 25 Fine weather the Ship in port Crenshawford getting Water got one raft and stowed it the Cooper setting up Shook

Thursday ~~Friday~~ March 26 Fine weather Ship in port Crenshawford Loring head stays got two Boat loads of Wood the Cooper setting up Shook the Starboard Watch on liberty at one PM the Capt started for Auckland

Friday March 27 Thought this day a strong gale with heavy Rain by night Crenshawford Flaming Wood in the hole sent down the Spanker Gaff and put in a new yoo neck the Cooper setting up Shook the Port Watch on liberty at two PM the Ship started her anchor let go the second anchor

Saturday March 28 Ship lying in port Continual Rain sent a raft of Cargoes on shore and filled them Cooper employed buying of barrels sent eleven barrels on shore
