First part cloudy the wind
from the SE finished stowing
of the hold fitted the fore
royal rigging. Cleaned the
churn flatts and painted
them. Commenced painting
the bends later part of this
day thick and rainy
Christian Robert was brought in
and taken on board the ship.

Wednesday April 1st

Fine weather
Ship in port the crew employed
painting at twelve the Captain
arrived from Suk and with
two Boat Steerers finished
painting

Thursday April 2

Shipped six barrels
of Bone by Steamer Roosara to the
Bay of Islands to be shipped home
by the Ship Tiger of New Bedford
March 415

Thursday April 2

First part fine
Weather the crew employed
in the rigging getting the
Ship ready for sea
Pela Antoki and Labrick Hicks Boat-
Steerers Deserted Took Vanhorn Seaman on board

Friday April 3 Sea account -

Fine weather the
Ship ready for sea at six AM
The Capt came on board took
our anchor and went out side
the heads and anchored in the
outer harbor at 10 PM got
under way and went to sea
with a light breeze from the
SE so ends this day

Saturday April 4

Came in with a
fresh breeze from the NE the
Ship heading NNW at dark took
in light sails middle part the
same later part Ship heading
to SE with a fresh breeze

Sunday April 5

Through this day
a fresh breeze from NNE Ship
heading E fine weather

Fine weather from
the NE the Ship heading to

one cutting the other Steaming
to the SE with all sail set
