Friday, April 17 Throught this day a fresh breeze from W to S Ship on different tacks Cruising at nine PM sighted the French Rock

Saturday, April 18 Fine weather from the SE Ship on the port tack Roadme, at 2 PM it was Ab Sailed the Calico Lat 31-22

Sunday, April 19 Throught this day light airs & Calms Spoke the Calico Lat 31-30 Lon 178-53

Monday, April 20 Throught this day Calm sent down the fore sail & fore top galant sail and repaired them

Tuesday, April 21 First and midl part calm later part a light breeze from the SE Ship heading to SW Cruising under flood clearing the Underles one sail in sight Lat 31-53 Lon 179-35

in the South Pacific 1871

Wednesday, April 22 Throught this day light airs and Calms the Ched employed painting the Underles &c Lat 32-28

Thursday, April 23 First part calm Middle & later part a strong Gale from the SE Ship heading to the SW Cruising Lat 32-56 Lon 178-56

Friday, April 24 Throught this day a strong breeze from the SE the Ship Cruising clearing different courses to the SE at one PM spoke the Bark Rainbow Lat 32-58 Lon 177-42

Saturday, April 25 Throught this day a fresh breeze from the SE and overcast Ship Cruising heading from N to NE no observations this day

Sunday, April 26 Throught this day a strong breeze from the NE Ship heading W by N Cruising Lat 32-46 Lon 17-48
