Thursday August 27

Fine weather from the S three Boats of Crusing Employed on board Bailing at nine PM finished Bailing

Friday August 28

Fine weather from the SE four Boats of Crusing

Saturday August 29

Continues fine first part light later part calm four Boats of Crusing

Sunday August 30

Strong breeze from the S first part four Boats of Crusing later part on the Cranes

Monday August 31

Fresh breeze from the SE four Boats of Crusing The Bark Onward left here this day with one Whale

Tuesday September 1st

A strong Gale SE the Boats on the Cranes Employed on board cleaning bone
