Friday, Sept 18

Fine weather Three Boats of Crusing Employed on board Cutting blubber at three PM started the works

Saturday, Sept 19

Fine from the E Three Boats of Crusing at Twelve finished Baling have seen no Whales this day

Sunday, Sept 20

Fine weather and a light breeze from the E Leabard and Waist Boat of Crusing Employed on board Stowing down Oil

Monday, Sept 21

a light breeze from the E and Smoky weather first part four Boats of Crusing later part on board sent up Degalant yards and Land no Whales

Tuesday, Sept 22

Brought this day a fresh breeze from the NNE with Rain the Boats on the Cranes Employed on board Cleaning Ship

Wednesday, Sept 23

Continues thick Rainy weather from the NNE

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
