Sept Thursday 24 Fine weather from the E fear boats of cruising land no Whales

Friday Sept 25

A fresh breeze and smoky weather from ENE At eight P.M. got under way and went to sea through Long Island Passage the day ends with a fresh breeze from ENE and smoky weather Ship heading N. Baanpton Reef in sight to windward

Saturday Sept 26

First and middle part a fresh breeze from ENE Ship heading N. Later part the same the crew employed setting rigging etc

Sunday Sept 27

Came in with a fresh breeze from ENE Ship heading SE at eleven P.M. tacked heading N. later part heading from E to SE on the Port tack with a fresh breeze and smoky

Monday Sept 28

First part a fresh breeze and smoky weather from ENE Ship heading ESE Middle part the same later part light baffling winds from the N and smoky weather

Lat 18-44

Tuesday Sept 29

First and middle part light baffling winds from all points with rain. Specially later part a light breeze from E the Ship heading NNE

Wednesday Sept 30

Thought this day a fresh breeze from the E and fine weather Ship heading NNE

Thursday Sept October 1st

First and middle part a strong breeze from E later part Specially from ENE with Rain Ship heading NNE
