Friday October 2

First part a fresh breeze from the E. Kille port. The same ship heading N. Later part a light breeze ship heading N. W. E. at nine P.M. Rose the Sear and this day ends with a light breeze and fine weather ship heading N. W. W. land distant forty miles.

Saturday October 3

Throught this day light breeze & Calms ship heading to the SW along the land.

Sunday October 4

Came in fine from the E at one P.M. a canoe came along side with Natives in her. At four P.M. dropped anchor. At three P.M. got under way and went to sea and cleared to the NW along the land this day ends calm.

Monday October 5th

First part a light breeze from the N. Ship on different tacks. Middle part going aback of Makira Bay. Later part a light breeze from the N. Ship heading up the bay and at twelve came to with the Port anchor.

Tuesday October 6th

Fine ship lying at anchor. First part Employed Skrubbing ship out side. Later part Employed bracking out the fore peak & betw. Landers and landing back.

Wednesday October 7

Ship lying at anchor. Employed getting wood and water. Weather Squally.

Thursday October 8

Fine. Crew employed getting wood & water. Sent a Boat of 10 trade for yams.

Friday October 9

Fine ship lying at anchor. Crew employed getting wood & water. Sent one Boat of 10 trade for yams.

Saturday October 10

Ship lying at anchor. Crew employed getting wood and water. One Boat of trading.

Sunday October 11

Raining. Ship lying at anchor. The crew ashore in Liberty.
