deserted
At nine AM took our anchor
and went to sea this day ends
with light baffling winds with
Rain

Sunday, October 18

Sea account
a light breeze from the ESE
Ship heading ESE will part
from ESE ship heading NW
at nine PM rose the Island of
Remell passed to the N of it
A Frank Silva of duty Lat 10-13
with Neneaniel Lon 177-20

First part a fresh
breeze from ESE ship heading
NW at nine AM passed the
North end of Remell Island
Middle part a light breeze ship
heading NW later part a strong
breeze from the E ship heading NW
