First part a light breeze and overcast from the SSE middle and later part fresh from the N Ship heading SSE

First part a light breeze from the SW middle part the same later part a light air and overcast from the N

Monday November 12

First part a light breeze from the NE middle part Wind hauled to the W with a heavy squall later part a heavy Gale from WSW Ship lying under a close reef main topsail on the Starboard Tack

Tuesday November 13

Thought this day a terrific Gale from SW with heavy rain squalls at two PM took in the main topsail Ship lay by on the Port Tack raining badly and shipping some water

Lat 37 05

Wednesday November 14

Comes in more moderate from the S Ship heading WSW middle and later part a fresh breeze and overcast from SSE Made sail heading SW no observation this day

Thursday November 15

First part a light breeze and overcast from SE Gained the Bark Ethel four days from Hobart town Middle part the same later part the same Ship heading to SE all sail set
