Thought - this day a fresh breeze from E to N Ship carrying all sail steering SE no observation this day

Saturday November 14
Thought - this day a fresh breeze from the N Ship carrying all sail heading SE by E

Thought - this day a fresh breeze from the N Ship heading SE by E all sail set

Monday November 16
Thought - this day a light breeze and overcast Ship heading SE and under way making Sprung

Thought - this day light breeze and overcast from the S Ship heading ESE on the Starboard tack at 24 Ah Shortened Sail at nine Oh rose the land dist thirty five miles

Wednesday November 18
First part a fresh breeze from the S Ship heading ESE at seven Ah backed Ship heading WNW land dist three miles middle part a light breeze later part a strong breeze and cloudy from the N at ten Oh rose Solander Rock took in sail and came to on the Starboard tack heading WNW

Thursday November 19
First part a heavy Gale from the S took in the main topsail Solander Rocks in sight to leeward middle and later part a heavy Gale Ship heading WNW on the Starboard tack

Friday November 20
Came in with a heavy Gale from the S Roared up the Starboard & Waist Boat at three Ah and veered to the W middle and later part of this day more moderate from the N & W made tail and steamed to the NE

Saturday November 21
First part a strong breeze from the NW and squally middle part a strong Gale close reefed the main topsail later part fine weather from WNW with a fresh breeze Ship on distant tack the Rock in sight
