Monday, Decem²⁸

First part a strong Gale from W Ship on stident tack under close reef topped. Middle part more moderate from WSW at nine the rose Bark Legoda Whaling to landward made sail and beat to landward at eleven the rose the Whales leaved the waist Boat from the Harbor came Whales went to landward called the Boat on board made sail and beat to landward this day ends with a strong breeze and squally from W

Tuesday, Decem²⁹

Came in with a strong breeze and squally at one PM. landed two Boats for Spinn Whales the Harbor Boat struck and line parted at three came on board and shortened sail the Legoda to seaward at six spoke the Tamerlane and Legoda Capt Lewis came on board. Middle part a strong Gale forced the foretop sail later part a heavy Gale from the NW Ship lying under close reef main topsail on the Starboard tack

of Leland's Rocks 1879

Wednesday, Decem³⁰

First part a heavy Gale from NW forced the main topsail Ship heading NNE on the Starboard tack. Middle part more moderate set the main topsail at six the rose ship and made sail heading SSW this day ends with a fresh breeze from W and a rough sea

First part a fresh breeze from W Ship heading NNE Middle part a light breeze later part backing with Rain lighted the Pinacles
