Friday, January 15

Comes in calm at six PM a light breeze from the NW Short Sail and headed to SE Middle part light -
+ Fine later part a fresh breeze from NW

Saturday, January 16

Comes in with a strong Gale from the NW Ship heading E Wind increasing at three PM Shortened Sail and in light to the SE more ship heading W Middle part a strong Gale and overcast later part the same furled the main topsail

of Solander Rock

Sunday, January 17

Just and Middle part The NW with a heavy sea at six PM near ship heading SE let the main topsail later part a fresh breeze from WNW at nine PM lighted the back ship heading NNE this day ends with a strong breeze from NW and squally two sails in light

Monday, January 18

Through this day a strong Gale from the NW and Squally The ship on different tacks Cruising The Solander Rock in light to the E

Tuesday, Jan 19

Continues a strong Gale from the NW and overcast ship on different tacks Cruising The Rock in light

Wednesday, January 20

Continues a strong Gale from the NW Ship on different tacks Thick overcast weather lighted the Rock
