part a fresh breeze at night.
At rose the Larnalane Whaling
Co. Standard made all sail
in chase so ends this day.

Friday January 22
At one PM rose
the Whales going to windward
loaded three boats did not
get fast at seven turned the
Larnalane. Middle part fine
weather from the E. later part
a strong breeze and thick
weather from the NW. The
Bark in sight bearing SE dist
twenty five miles.

Saturday Jan 23
Thought this day
a strong Gale from the NW.
Ship going under a close reef
Main topsail on the Starboard
lack, heading NW. Thick fog
with some rain.

Sunday January 24
Thought this day
a heavy Gale from W. with heavy
squalls. Ship on distant lack
under a close reef. Main topsail
lost - 47-08
Scan 189-23

Monday January 25
First part a heavy
Gale from W. to SW. Ship under
a close reef. Main topsail on distant
lack. Middle part more moderate
from the SW. Set a close reef
for topsail on the Port lack
at eleven AM rose the Eliza Adams
whaling Co. Standard made
all possible sail and beat to windward
at a strong breeze and squally from SW.

Tuesday January 26
Comes in with
a strong breeze and squally from
the SW. Loaded three boats for skin
whale. The Eliza Adams boats & ship
& whales went to windward
Middle part squally from the W.
later part from the N. with heavy
squalls. Ship under main sails.
