making, Line! Lat 33-41

Wednesday, April 28
First part Calm
middle and later part a light
breeze from the N ship heading
WNN Windemfloet making
Line! Lat 33-25
Lon 113-35

Thursday, April 29
Thought this
day a fresh breeze from the E
Ship heading WNN

Friday, April 30
First and middle
part a fresh breeze and air
lost from the N ship heading
WNN Later part a light air
with Rain squalls
No observations this day

a Passage to the Westward 1875

Saturday, May 1
First and middle
part light baffling winds with
heavy Rain later part a strong
breeze from the SE and squally
Ship heading WNN Lat 30-33
Lon 109-21

Sunday May 2
First part a strong
breeze and squally from the SE
Ship heading WNN Middle part
took in light sails and laid
aback at daylight made sail and
steared WNN at seven rose Norfolk
Island and steared for it
at noon the Island bore N dist
five to six miles this day

Monday May 3
First part a strong
breeze at mid day going a back
of Philips Island getting lighter
middle and later part a strong
breeze and overcast Ship heading
WNN all sail set Lat 28-06
