a light breeze from SSW

Friday May 7 Throught this day
a fresh breeze from N. SW of
Ship heading NW at sunset
Shortened Lail & remployed
making Spinnaker
Lat 24-13
Lon 150-40

Saturday May 8 First part a fresh
breeze from the SW ship on
the Port tack heading NW
middle part light later part
a fresh breeze at Indire had
a heavy Squall from the S
so ends this day
Lat 24-49
Lon 150-02

Sunday May 9 Throught this day
light fine weather from
the SW ship on different
tacks Cruising
Lat 24-13
Lon 158-39

Monday May 10 First part a light
breeze from the SW and fine
middle and later part a strong
breeze from the NW ship on
different tacks Cruising
Lat 23-57
Lon 158-59
