First part a strong gale with heavy rain from the E ship heading from S to SE with part the same at three PM a heavy squall from the SW to NW striking the ship a back gale the main topsail later part a light breeze from the NW ship heading to the N

First part fine with a fresh breeze from the SW Employed stowing oil in the after hold ship heading SW
