the S. no observations

Tuesday, June 8th
First part a fresh
breeze from the S and Squally
later part calm with heavy
squalls. Saw black fish leaped
three boats did not get fast

Throught this day
a fresh breeze from the S & W ship
clearing to the N & E earned
the Bay of Pagan had seen whales
the S.
