part a strong gale from the
N with rain Ship on the Port-
tack later part from the W
and S with a strong gale

Tuesday June 30

Throught this day
a strong gale from the SW
and squally spoke the brig
Velocity of Robert Gordon
Lat 23-47

Wednesday June 30

More moderate
from the S Ship on different
tacks Cruising
Lat 23-31
Long 158-54

Thursday July 1

Fresh breeze from the
S Ship Cruising spoke the brig
Velocity no observations this day

Friday July 2

First and Middle part
a fresh breeze and squally from
the E spoke the brig, Provier
later part a strong breeze with
rain squalls from the NE
Ship heading to the SE
no observations

Saturday July 3

First part a strong
gale from the SW with heavy
rain close reefed the main
top sail Mid part the same
later part a strong breeze from
the S Ship heading SE
Lat 23-40
Long 159-13
