Tuesday July 20th First and middle part ship heading to the Sth on the Starboard tack and from the Sth later part on the port tack heading ESE a fresh breeze & breezy weather
Lat 28-33.
Long 178-52

Wednesday July 21st A fresh breeze from NNE ship on the port tack heading ENE
Lat 28-58
Long 179-58 = W

Thursday July 22nd First part a fresh breeze from the NE middle part a fresh breeze with rain from the Sth ship heading NE by N
Lat 29-13

Friday July 23rd Thought this day a fresh breeze and overcast from the Sth ship heading NE all sail set - no observations this day

Saturday July 24th Thought this day a strong breeze from the SE and equally ship heading ENE all sail set
Lat 28-42
Long 179-10 W

Sunday July 25th Fine weather and a fresh breeze from the SE ship heading NE all sail set
Lat 21-09
Long 173-15

Monday July 26th First part a strong breeze from the SE ship heading NE middle part the same later part a strong breeze at half past eleven & the rose the Island of Navan bore away for it steered W so ends this day a strong breeze and overcast

Tuesday July 27th First and middle part a strong Gale and equally ship heading of and on in the passage later part more moderate ship working up to the anchorage so ends this day
