Wednesday July 28
At one PM Sea came
down to with the Bark anchor
at Nauru later put Crendell
and Lilling the foretopmast
yard the Capt on board
trading with the natives
for goods David, Canacker
Deserted

Thursday July 29
Ship lying at anchor
Crendell and Lilling left Nauru
rigging and making new
flying jib pennants
Capt on board trading

Friday July 30
Ship lying at anchor
The Crendell and Lilling the
Nauru rigging the Capt of
with a Boat trading for
goods a strong breeze from
the E

Saturday July 31
The Ship lying
at anchor The Crendell
and Lilling Nauru rigging and
jib pennant trading for
goods

at anchor at Nauru 1875-

Sunday August 1st
At eight PM
took our anchor and went
further down the Bay and came
to with the Starboard anchor
in thirty fathoms of water
fired out 24 fathoms gave
the Bark Lillied at anchor
Bear Shuck his first Whale
and Lark him

Monday August 2nd
Fine weather
Ship lying at anchor Lared
four Boats to Cruise for
Whale Backs Lard none

Tuesday August 3rd
Got under way
and started for the Starboard
at twelve hoisted three Boats
for a Cow & calf Lard several
other Whales

Wednesday August 4th
At twelve
came to with the Starboard
Anchor at the top the Nauru
Boat lying at anchor here
