Killed with the Bay Trapper

Friday August 6
Strong hedge
from the E. four Boats of
Ensigning, Saw but few Whales

Saturday August 7
Strong hedge
from NE to NW four Boats
of Ensigning, Saw but few Whales
and very little
William Hart not being capable of performing
his duty as Boat Steerer directed him to
Seaman

Sunday August 8
Fine weather
Saw several Whales from the
Ship did not Coar

Monday August 9
Fresh hedge from
the E. four Boats of Ensigning
Saw but few Whales and very
little

at Anchor at the Hapaes

Tuesday August 10
Strong hedge and
Largely from the NE Coarced
three Boats Saw one Whale
in the distance at eleven
P.M. Came on board

Wednesday August 11
Fine weather
from the NE four Boats
in Ensigning one of the Trappers
Boats struck the Iron break
Saw but few Whales
Henry Ray Deserted

Thursday August 12
At seven P.M. got
under way and steared to the West
Saw fine weather and a fresh hedge
from ENE left the Bay Trapper at
anchor two Boats of Whaling

Friday August 13
Fine weather and
a fresh hedge from the E. Ship heading
for the SW all sail set
Credemphord fitting Cutting Blocks
Lat 20° 15'
Long 176° 20'
