Monday Sept 22

First part a strong
breeze from the NE at two P.M.
lighted the land thick withcast -
Another ship heading S by E
at seven A.M. doubled reaped the
topsails and furled the courses
cleared SE at eleven P.M. close
reaped the main topsail and
were to on the port tack heading
E at day light made sail
and cleared SE a fresh breeze
and thick fog at twelve
passed Cape Pilon a light
breeze and clear

Tuesday Sept 23

First part light
breeze from the N at midnight.
Wind hauled to the WSW a
heavy Gale. Hove the ship to
under close reef main topsail
heading S by W later part more
moderate made sail
and beat up the Bay

Wednesday Sept 24

First part a strong
breeze from the WSW and squally
at three P.M. raised Cape Horn
at seven P.M. the Iron put light
at first night anchored at the former
with a fresh breeze down river

Thursday Sept 30

Ship lying at anchor
strong gale with heavy squalls
at anchor down employed cleaning
ship

Friday October 1

Moderate with rain squalls
at anchor under way and went
along side the wharf

Saturday Oct 2

Ship along side the
wharf. Fine weather clear employed
baking out the after hold
and stowing back

Sunday October 3

Strong breeze and
fine weather Ship at anchor. Left the
dock
