At 10 AM ship at anchor
Day and beat down the river
light passing under the bridge
this day bound to Sydney to ship
men

Saturday October 29
First part light
breeze from the S at five PM passed
the Iron pot light Matilda part-
light fine weather later part the
same ship heading E by S light
breeze from the NE (fine blue hazy)
at last fifteen 16
