Throughout this day fine weather from the S.W. Ship on distant tacks cruising the Rock in sight. Landed the Eliza Adams.

First and Kildale part fine weather from the S.W. later part a strong breeze from W. Ship on distant tacks cruising the Rock in sight.

Sunday Dec 16

First part a strong breeze from W.W. Ship on distant tacks cruising the Rock in sight. Kildale & later part a strong Gale from the S.W. Ship under storm sails heading W.W. The Rock in sight a storm dist thirty N.

Monday Dec 17

Came in with a heavy Gale from the S.W. Ship lying under heavy stay sail at five P.M. loaded the heavy Boat under and broke her in two and hoisted the Harbor Boat Kildale part more moderate at seven A.M. took in the Harbor Boat and repaired her. Wind from the N.W. thick and raining. Ship on the starboard tack heading N.
