Wednesday Decem 22

Came in fine at seven PM marked cutting and hooked on to the case at eleven & finished taking the case at eight AM started the by hook. This day ends fine with light breezes from the SE the cock sailing & dist 20 W the Tamerlane in light cutting,

Thursday Decem 23

Thought this day fine weather from the SE & E mild breeze the cock in light to the W dist 20 had the Bark Chance beating out of the straits

Friday Decem 24

First and middle part fine weather from the NW E mild breeze the cock sailing W dist 15 W later part a strong gale from WSW the Tamerlane in light sailing at middle back sailing at nine AM kept off for Port Plover with a strong gale from WSW

Saturday Decem 25

First part a strong gale with heavy squalls from the W at 1 PM came in with the Starboard anchor at Port Wharfe middle part more moderate gale last the same finished sailing

Sunday Decem 26 Sea account

Commenced to brake out in the fore hole to Port Oil middle part fine from the SE later part a fresh breeze and overcast the Bark Chance out side the beach with a whole

Tuesday Decem 28

Came in with a fresh breeze with fog and rain from the E at one PM got under way and went to sea at seven PM shortened sail of Solander Beach have to under a close reef rain to sail on Starboard tack heading N this day ends with a fresh breeze from ESE ship on distant tack with close reef to sails the cock in light to the E the Eliza Adams in light

Wednesday Decem 29

Thought this day thick weather from ESE with moderate breezes ship are distant takes cruising the Tamerlane & Eliza Adams in light the cock in light to the E
