First part a fresh breeze
from the W. Ship on the Starboard
Tack the Bark Chance to Windward
the Rock bearing SE dist 25 M
at three M rose three Whales
to Windward hoared three boats
the Starboard Boat struck
the Whale leaped high bent
on the Main Boat line leaped
out his large tub when the
line parted Whales went to
leeward the Chance Boat struck
and got him the Whales started
to Windward chased until sunset
and came on board
Middle and later part light
variable air and clear

Tuesday Jan 18
Throught this day
fine light weather from the S.E.
Ship on light tacks Cruising
to the S.W. of the Rock

Wednesday Jan 19
First part calm &
fine light air from the S.W.
at three M rose three Whales hoared
three boats did not get fast
Middle part calm later part a
light breeze and fine from the S.E.
the rock to the SE
