Monday February 14

First part a strong breeze from the W Ship heading off the N along the South side of Stenard's Island at eight. At a harbor of Tolsons inlet. Middle part fine lying at anchor at four. At four under way and beat around to Port William at eight. Came to with Harbors anchor the Towerland and Chance in harbor.

Ship lying at anchor at Port William. Wind from the NW. Look threatening and boat of fishing. E. Bore new Main topsail, jibs and Main Tacks.

Wednesday Feb 16

A strong Gale from the NW with rain.

Thursday Feb 17

Ship lying at anchor at Port William a strong breeze from the W. At four the second anchor the Edge of James came in reports bad weather of Solander.

Friday Feb 18

Ship lying at Port William light breeze from the NW and overcast.

Saturday Feb 19

First part Middle part Ship lying at Port William at nine. At four under way with a light breeze from the NW at twelve passed Bench Island and cleared E of N thick with rain.
