all Sail set heading NW
Employed repairing fore Topsail

all Sail set. Hoisted fore Topsail
later part a fresh breeze with
Rain from the NE
no observations

Monday May 29
First part a strong
breeze with Rain from the ESE
Ship heading NW under Stow
Topsail & Foresail Middle part
the same later part Wind
shifted to the SE with a strong
breeze and heavy Rain
Ship heading NW
no observations

Tuesday May 30
Thought this day
a strong Gale from the SE
Ship heading NW
thick with Rain

Wednesday 31
First and Middle part
a fresh breeze from the E
Ship heading NW all Sail
set later part light baffling
breeze with a heavy swell
