Saturday July 22^d Fine weather and a
fresh breeze from WNW ship heading
N and NW

Lat 23-7
Lon 163-28

Sunday July 23^d Thought this day
a strong breeze from NW ship
heading to the NW
Lat 22-15
Lon 163-31

Monday July 24^d First part a strong
breeze from the SW ship heading
WNW Middle part the same
later part moderate with a
head wind from the SW wind
from the S. Parked fore Royal
back stay sent it down and
sprung it -

Lat 22-15-
Lon 162-31

Tuesday July 25^d Thought this day
a fresh breeze from the SE
ship heading WNW all day
Set course to Barnham Reefs
Lat 20-00
Lon 160-53

and lying at Anchor at Barnham

Wednesday July 26^d First part a fresh
breeze and fine from SE ship
heading WNW Middle part
a fresh breeze heading W later
part a fresh breeze and overcast -
at half past eleven the rose
two vessels lying at anchor
at Chesterfield Shoals to enter
this day

Thursday July 27^d Sea account -
At three PM came
to with the Starboard Anchor
the Bark Onward and Brig
Velocity at anchor here shelling
The crew employed dry casks with
Salt Water to swell. Sent my fore
Royal back stay 44 no whales
seen in the day but few out side

Friday July 28^d Fine weather from
the S. Sent down the Mainmast
and Main Topmast for repairs
Saw a no of whales from the ship
the Onward & Velocity boats in
chase
