at half past one A.M. started
to cut the Starboard and
Bow Boat fast at six finish
cutting the Starboard Boat and
Bow Boat got there whale to the
ship fluked him and set
the watch a good third of Whales
to day

Friday August 25
At day light
started to cut at eight started
the by work at two am
finished cutting and loaded
the Starboard Boat for a whale
did not get fast all hands
employed cutting up Blubber
and boiling

Saturday August 26
The PM and Fine weather from
a light breeze
loaded the Bow and Bow
Employed on board cutting
Blubber and boiling
at eight PM Starboard Boat struck
at half past nine took him
along side finished cutting
Blubber and hooked on to
the whale to cut him in
the waist and Bow Boat chasing
a whale at three PM came
on board at four AM finished
cutting

Sunday August 27
Fine weather and
a fresh breeze from the SE four Boats
of Cruising Employed on
board boiling land but few
Whales finished Boiling

Monday August 28
A strong breeze
from the SE four Boats of
Cruising the Cooper employed
Coopering Oil

Tuesday August 29
Continues a strong
breeze from the SE the Boats
on the Cranes First part
Employed filling Boats and
repairing by work later part
stowing Oil in the fore hold
