finished Boiling Landed four boats
to cruise and cut and whales.

Sunday Sept 3
A strong breeze
from the SE. Landed four boats
at twelve the Starboard Boat
struck at four AM. Started to
load the whale to the ship.

Monday Sept 4
Strong breeze from the E
at three PM. Got the whale to the
ship after seven hours hard rowing
at seven looked on to cut him in
at four AM finished cutting and
took in the Starboard Boat for repairs
having him stowed by a sea fast
to the whale.

Tuesday Sept 5
Fine weather from the E
two boats of cruising
employed on board cutting slabs
boiling and repairing the Starboard
finished the boat and put her out.

Wednesday Sept 6
First part a fresh breeze
from the SE. Employed boiling
at daylight finished boiling
and landed four boats. The
Starboard Boat struck at twelve
took him along side at dark
had him cut in a fresh breeze
from the SE.

Thursday Sept 7
A strong breeze from
the SE. Three boats of cruising
employed on board boiling
at one PM. Two boats came on board
and stowed oil in the main
hold.
