Sunday Sept 17

First part fine weather and a light air from the NW. Started oil in the fore hole at nine PM started to cut at five finished cutting and started the try work a strong breeze from the SE

at Banffton 1878

Monday Sept 18

Thought this day a strong breeze from the SE Employed on board cutting blubber and boiling. Started some oil in the main hole.

Tuesday Sept 19

Thought this day a strong breeze from the SE. Saw no whales from the ship the Cooper repairing corks.

Wednesday Sept 20

A strong breeze from the SE loosed three boats for whales the Harbord Boat struck at five PM got him to the ship. Employed on board ship cooping oil.

Thursday Sept 21

Continues a strong breeze from the SE at day light. Started to stow oil in the main hole finished stowing down and hooked on to cut in the whale at five PM finished cutting and started the try work.
