First part -
a strong breeze from E
Ship on the Starboard tack
heading NNE middle part -
the same later part heading
N at twelve o'clock ship
heading SE a strong breeze
and overcast - no variations

First and middle
part a strong breeze from ENE
Ship on the Port tack heading
SE later the wind veered to the
W with heavy rain thunder and
lightning Ship heading NNE

First part light
baffling wind and calm from
the W middle and later part -
a moderate breeze and fine
from the SE ship heading NNE
the Cooper repairing Casks

SE ship heading to the N all
at 12
